## What's Happening at the Depot Museum

For 26 years the North Creek Depot Museum has been dedicated to conserving and preserving the local historical heritage of the Johnsburg area – specifically Theodore Roosevelt, Skiing, and the Rail Road – for future generations. As we wind down our 2018 season, we have welcomed almost 4,300 visitors.

This year we launched some great new exhibits at the Museum. In July we dedicated our Interactive Teddy Roosevelt Kiosk. This consists of a touch-screen computer that is linked to the Teddy Roosevelt Center at Dickinson State University and provides a wealth of information on our 26<sup>th</sup> President. In addition, a new video, documenting the life and activities of Dr. Thomas Durant and the Adirondac Railroad, now complements our railway display.

Another exciting announcement for the museum: Linda and Mike Quintavalle, have generously donated a 1940's vintage caboose for our outdoor display. Plans are underway to renovate it for use as an interactive exhibit and classroom space for our education programs. Also by resolution, the Town Council of Johnsburg granted us exclusive use of a rare, circa 1900, D&H Milk Car.



This historic rail car needs major restoration and preservation; however, as it is one of only four known to still be in existence, it will surely prove to be an invaluable asset to our collection.


